Driving directions From **ITHACA**, take Route 13 South to Route 327. Make a right turn on 327 follow it up the hill, approximately 4 miles, past the entrances to Robert H. Treman State Park to Hines Road and the PINECREEK sign. Make a left turn on Hines Road and make the very next right turn on Rockwell Road and there it is, PINECREEK CAMPGROUND!
